

TEMPORARY COURSE CLOSURE

EFFECTIVE MARCH 25th, 2020

The COVID-19 Pandemic has hit us all incredibly fast, and like all of you, we at GGL are doing everything we can to slow the curve of the virus. We have taken many steps to make playing golf at GGL as safe as possible, including eliminating golf cart rentals, closing the Pro Shop except for window service, not allowing cash sales and encouraging pre-payment with a credit card, removing rakes and sand bottles, and demanding proper social distancing. The announcement on March 23rd, 2020 of Executive Order 20-12 orders all of us to "Stay Home and Practice Social Distancing", and states that all non-essential activities must be avoided. As much as we love it, Golf could certainly be described as non-essential. The order also says that some outdoor activities can be enjoyed as long as proper social distancing is adhered to. With the rapidly changing guidance, we are going to take a brief, but deep pause, and close the golf course until further notice. We will monitor everything very closely this week, and with any luck, be back playing golf sooner than later. We want all of our Members, Guests, and Employees happy and healthy, and golfing for a long, long time. More importantly, we want to do our best to join the national effort to slow the curve of infection. We realize some may think this is unnecessary or an overreaction given all the other precautions we have made, but we want to be sure we have done all we can. A few days off the golf course, and at home safe, is a small price to pay for our health.
